Lab Robes for Veterans

In 2007, Nancy Van Apeldoorn began a journey to honor her friend..."Wally". She founded Lap Robes for Veterans as a way to give back to those who sacrifice so much, and to say "Thank You for Your Service." What started as one, quickly turned into more than 10,000 lap robes in just 12 years with the help of more than 50 volunteers and support from the community. Walter H. "Wally" Gekoski died in 2007 at the age of 59 from complications of Agent Orange. Wally was a US Marine Veteran of the Vietnam War serving from 1966-1969, a 27-year member of the Kendall Volunteer Fire Department, a Medic and was a proud member of the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 20. Since 2007 the number of lap robes made and given to veterans has grown.

Many organizations are impacted by the donations of Lap Robes for Veterans: Honor Flight Rochester, Monroe Community Hospital, Fairport Baptist Nursing Home, Lifetime Hospice, and other numerous small hospices, many VVA Chapters in NY state, VA Facilities, Gold Star Mothers in NY, American Legions, VFWs, Richards House, Pricilla Place...just to name a few. Nancy is married to Bruce Van Apeldoorn, MSgt. USMC Retired . Nancy and Bruce moved to North Caroline in 2021. At that time two dedicated volunteers Patty Verhagen and Sue Morris offered to continue the organizations mission and vision. They joined the Board of Directors in 2021 assuming oversight and manage-



ment of the organization. Nancy continues as a board member and resource.
